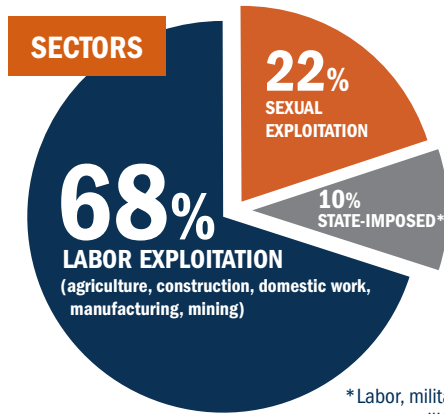


The Business of Modern Day SLAVERY

Human Rights First is bringing together governments, law enforcement and the private sector to dismantle—and eventually bankrupt—human trafficking.



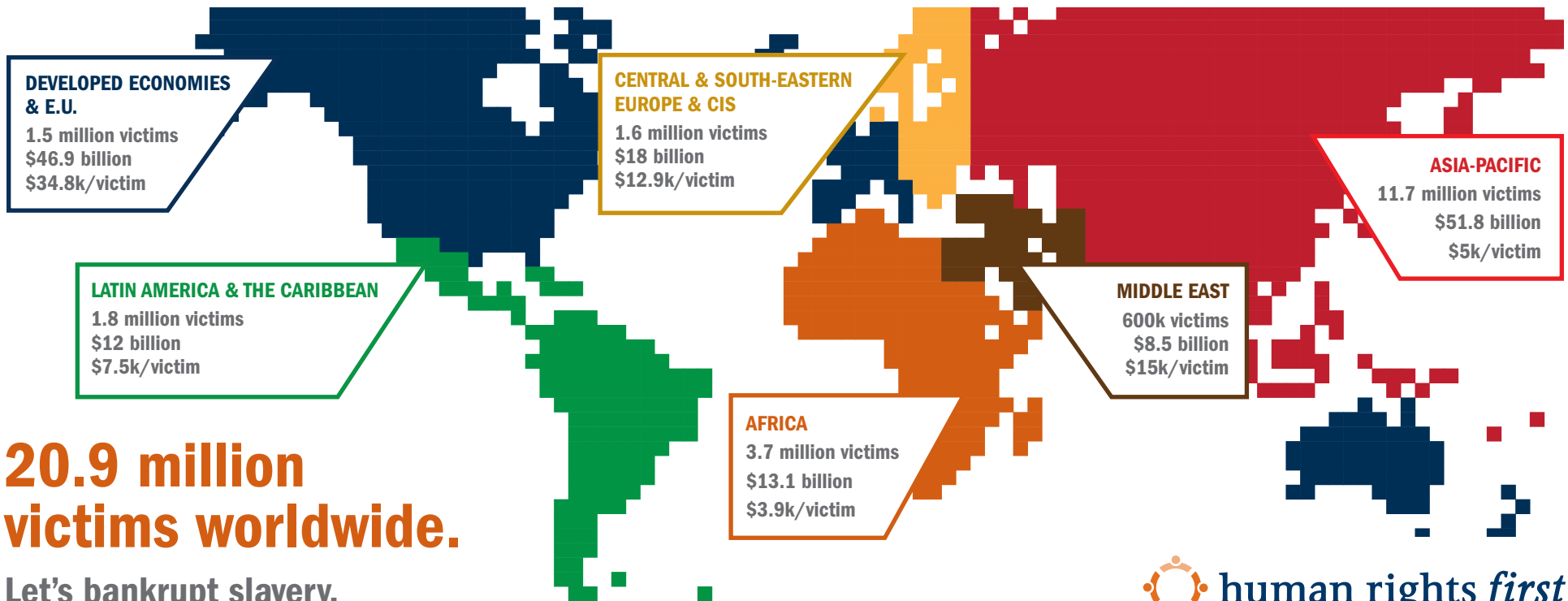
